

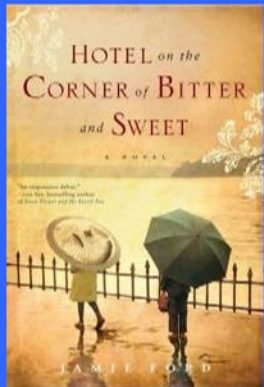

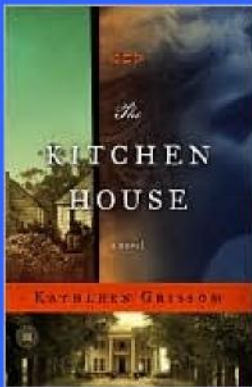
*Hotel on The Corner

Ford's book depicts the shame of what happened to Japanese Americans during World War II, ~ A wartime-era Chinese-Japanese variation on Romeo and Juliet...



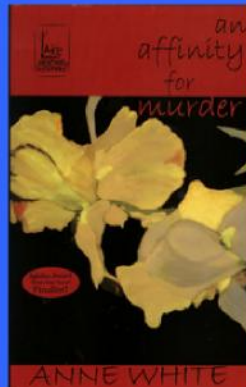
The Kitchen House

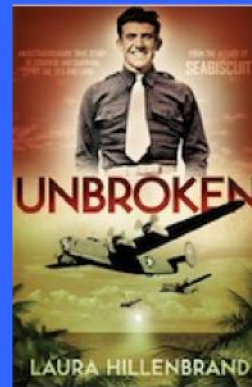
*An Affinity For Murder

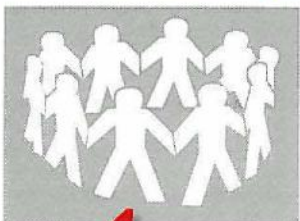
Unbroken
